### Highlights: Parent Satisfaction Survey – Spring 2009

- 98% of parents express satisfaction with the overall quality of education provided by FFCA.
- 97% of parents believe that FFCA offers parents a variety of volunteer opportunities.
- 97% of parents are satisfied that our school promotes physical activity, health and wellness.
- 97% of parents are happy with the way our school encourages respectful relationships among staff and students.
- 97% of parents feel that their role as a partner in education is respected by school staff.
- 97% of parents believe that FFCA's learning expectations are clearly communicated.
- 97% of parents are happy with the way FFCA recognizes student achievement.
- 97% of parents are satisfied with the way the school keeps them informed about their child's progress and achievement.
- 97% of parents are happy with the school's expectations for student behavior.
- 97% of parents are happy with the way they are welcomed when they visit the school.
- 96% of parents feel that there is a caring atmosphere at FFCA.
- 96% of parents feel that the vision, mission and values of FFCA are implemented consistently.
- 96% of parents are satisfied with the communications they receive from the school.
- 96% of parents believe that the school has a process for improving the quality of education it offers to students.
- 96% of parents believe that, given our focus on academics, character and leadership, the range of programming meets their child's needs.
- 96% of parents are happy with the academic results of their children at FFCA.
- 95% of parents believe that their child is learning the skills he/she needs.
- 95% of parents feel that School Council plays a meaningful role in the school.

### Highlights: Provincial Achievement Tests – Spring 2009

- Acceptable Standard: Alberta Education expects 85% of students to score at this level. On average, 93.5% of our students produced acceptable scores.
- Standard of Excellence: Alberta Education expects 15% of students to score at this level. On average, 31.7% of our students produced excellent scores.
- On average, 99% of our students wrote PAT's in all 10 subject areas (provincial average is 90.6%).
