BACKGROUND & RATIONALE

Uniforms serve many purposes. At FFCA, our school uniforms help students arrive at school with an attitude conducive to learning and work. Secondly, our uniforms help to create a sense of culture and belonging. When our students are in uniform outside the school, they represent FFCA and everything that FFCA stands for. Lastly, uniforms help eliminate socioeconomic differences and the tendency toward competition between students in the areas of dress and appearance. FFCA is a uniform school. All students arrive at school dressed in either their full gala uniform (high school) or their daily wear uniform as directed/required. The only exceptions will occur on predetermined casual days.

PROCEDURES

1. Determination of Standards
 - a. The Board of Directors will determine uniform standards for FFCA.
2. Enforcement
 - a. Any student who arrives at school out of proper uniform will be given a verbal warning.
 - b. If a student arrives at school out of proper uniform a second time, they will be given a uniform infraction ticket. This ticket will be sent home, signed by the parent/guardian and returned to school the next day.
 - c. Each campus will keep uniform supplies on hand. Any student out of uniform will be required to change into proper uniform. They are to take home the borrowed uniform item, launder it, and return it as soon as possible to their campus.
 - d. If a student arrives at school out of proper uniform a third time, a parent/guardian will be contacted to bring the proper uniform item to the school.
